Rotary Hospice helps individuals and families through the grieving process as they face the advanced illness or death of someone close to them. Our team of professionals provides individual, family, and group counselling, as well as 24-hour end-of-life care.

Opened in June 2019, Rotary Hospice has cared for 464 individuals since that time.

All at no cost to the individual.

Ministry of Health funding covers approximately 50% of annual operating costs, the rest - over \$1,000,000 must be fundraised locally.
